### **INFORMATION ON ACCOMMODATION BOOKING AND COMPETITION REGISTRATION SERVICES FOR LWC 2022**

#### **1. ACCOMMODATION PACKAGE PRICES**

The package prices that were originally available to all participants from 24 December 2019 will remain available for all new bookings up to **31 December 2021**. The details are available on the ORION event website: [www.lifesaving2022.com](http://www.lifesaving2022.com)

The only difference is that due to local legislative changes in the city of Riccione, the local city accommodation tax per person per night must be paid by that individual directly to the provider of the accommodation rather than the ORION agency. The 2019/2020 package prices are therefore reduced accordingly by ORION to account for this for new clients

As before ORION offers accommodation at different tariffs for Bed & Breakfast, Half Board and Full Board across a range of hotels from 2\* to 4\*, apartments and camping sites. If your intended stay is less than 5 nights or greater than 8, you must contact ORION directly on [info@orionskyglobal.com](mailto:info@orionskyglobal.com) to discuss your specific requirements.

For all new bookings from **1 January 2022**, the overall package prices will be increased in line with local rates for the hotels in Riccione for 2022. Details of these rates are not yet available. Wherever possible, participants are advised to make their bookings early to take advantage of these lower rates.

All payments for the accommodation packages must be made direct to ORION in accordance with their terms and conditions that are displayed on their website.

Please note that arrival into Riccione before 20 September 2022 is not advised due to other major global sporting events taking place in the two weeks prior to the start of LWC 2022 which will likely use all available accommodation in the city and surrounding area.

## 2. REGISTRATION STEP BY STEP

### A. REGISTRATION WITH ORION FOR THE PURCHASE OF ACCOMMODATION AND SERVICE PACKAGES

1. Go to the event website: [www.lifesaving2022.com](http://www.lifesaving2022.com)
2. Click on "Register to Event"
3. Fill in the requested fields: First name and family name, e-mail and choose a password.
4. Click on Register
5. Select your category: example National Teams, Club Teams
6. Select your Federation using the federation drop-down menu
7. If you are registering a club team, then select your club using the club drop-down menu, from the list of clubs approved by your Federation. If your club is not shown, select "Send Affiliation Request". You will need to wait for your club to be added to the **ILS List of Approved Club Names**. You will receive an e-mail to confirm when this has been done.
8. Select your competition: open, youth, masters, surfboat, IRB, etc
9. Select your hotel, the number of nights you wish to stay, and the category you want (i.e. Bed and Breakfast, Half Board, Full Board)
10. Provide payment details for the accommodation and the services and make your payment. The accommodation fees and services are collected by FIN-S through ORION.
11. When all the above steps are cleared, then you will receive a Competition Entry Code.
12. For periods of less than 5 nights, please contact ORION at [info@orionskyglobal.com](mailto:info@orionskyglobal.com) and they will assist you.
13. If in a later stage, you add or remove a competitor or team manager, this is possible by contacting ORION at [info@orionskyglobal.com](mailto:info@orionskyglobal.com) .

### B. OBTAINING AN ORGANET ACCOUNT

1. You are now able to register your team in the OrgaNet Competition Entry system. However, first you must obtain an OrgaNet account in order to access the system.

3. If you already have an account in OrgaNet that you may have used in the LWC 2018 events or 2019 European Championships, you can use this to register your team. In this case proceed directly to the steps below.

### C. REGISTRATION IN ORGANET

1. Go to the OrgaNet system at <https://ils.organet.info>
2. Login with your account details as obtained in B above.
3. Use the Register icon on the left-hand side of the screen of the Championships into which you want to register your team
4. Follow the instructions before completing the registration screen. Detailed guides are available through the ILS Website for the following types of registration:

5. Apply your Competition Entry Code that has been supplied to you by ORION into the ORION Code field – it will be in the format: LS20-37-XXXXX with a unique 5-digit number at the end.
6. This code can only be used once, and applies only to the specific Championships for which the team is being registered
7. **Payment of fees:**
  - Please do not pay the fees until your team's entry has been approved by the Local Organising Committee – you will receive an e-mail from OrgaNet when this has been done allowing you to finalise your entry
  - All individual competition fees are collected through the competition entry process, with payments made through PayPal.
  - All team competition fees are collected through the competition entry process with payments made through the PayPal icon
  - If you do not have a PayPal account, it is possible when you access the PayPal icon to simply choose to pay with a debit/credit card.
8. When submitting your registration, please ensure that you only click on the blue register bar once to avoid submitting a duplicate registration and receiving an error message.

### 3. COMPETITION ENTRY DEADLINES

The Lifesaving World Championships 2022 registration dates are as follows:

Period	Date from	Date to
Normal entry period	01/07/2021	09/08/2022
Late entry period	10/08/2022	24/08/2022
Very late entry period	Less than 7 days before the start of the competition: Individual fees will rise to 200 Euro per individual	

- All competition entries close on **24 August 2022**.
- Entries submitted after this date are only accepted by the ILS Event Management Committee.
- Changes to entries can be done up to 48 hours before the start of each championships free of charge.
- Changes made between 48 hours and 24 hours will cost 50 Euro per change.
- Changes made between 24 hours and 0 hours will cost 100 Euro per change.
- Competitors that were registered but do not start without a valid reason, will be sanctioned with a 50 Euro fee.
- Examples of a valid reason (not an exhaustive list) are:
  - If a competitor has a confirmed medical condition, that prevents them participating in an event.
  - If a competitor suffers a personal issue that prevents them from participating – e.g. they are unable to participate due to an unexpected bereavement of a family member or someone close to them, or are required to return to their home due to a domestic emergency.
- All such cases will be considered and signed off by the ILS Competition Committee before the exemption is confirmed

(\*\*) This fee is charged to help offset the annual costs of the “out-of-competition” testing processes and associated work that the ILS must conduct to ensure it remains compliant with WADA and can continue to maintain a clean sport for **all** who participate in Lifesaving Sport. This is why it is being applied to **all** competitors at LWC 2022. This is not charged to cover the costs of the anti-doping testing at the LWC 2022 which remain the host’s responsibility.
