



## ILS Statistical Summary - 2022

Article 14.4 of the World Anti-Doping Code requires that "Anti-Doping Organizations shall, at least annually, publish publicly a general statistical report of their Doping Control activities with a copy provided to WADA." Article 14.5 also requires that "WADA shall act as the central clearing house for Doping Control Testing data" from anti-doping organizations and "shall, at least annually, publish statistical reports summarizing such information."
